Susan Self spent 17 years with IBM Canada Ltd, both in Ontario and Manitoba for which she held management positions for seven years. She left in 1987, worked briefly for the Uxbridge Cottage Hospital Foundation, before entering municipal politics in 1988. Ms. Self spent three years as a Ward Councillor in Uxbridge, followed by 15 years as a Durham Regional Councillor – including six as Deputy Mayor for Uxbridge.

Ms. Self served for 15 years on the Board of Directors of the Central Lake Ontario and Lake Simcoe Region Conservation Authorities, including chair of LSRCA during 1997 and 1998.

In addition to her political career, Ms. Self founded a retail business, The Vintner’s Nook Inc, in 1996 and subsequently sold it in 2004. She is currently the chair of the Board of Referees for the Employment Insurance Commission for the Oshawa area.

Ms. Self resides in Uxbridge with husband Kennedy. Daughters Andrea and Lisa are both completing post graduate studies.
