Nancy works with Freshwater Future as the manager of partnerships. Freshwater Future is a binational charity working to ensure the healthy future of all waters in the Great Lakes region. The organization helps citizens engage in efforts to protect the natural environment by providing grants and offering consulting assistance to diverse communities and collaborators. Prior to Freshwater Future, Nancy worked with Environmental Defence, leading the Great Lakes program to educate citizens and governments about the need for stronger rules to protect and restore the Great Lakes. Listed as one of Tides Canada's Top 10 Visionaries in 2010, Nancy is also the founder of Blue Drinks Toronto, a social network of over 250 people engaged in meaningful dialogue and collaboration on water issues. She is the author of numerous academic journal articles, book chapters, conference proceedings, and regularly publishes opinion editorials, blogs, and magazine articles. Nancy began her water policy career as the program manager for the Forum for Leadership on Water (FLOW). Nancy has a Master's of Environmental Studies degree in planning from the University of Waterloo.
