Wendy Burgess

Golf Course Industry

For the past two decades, Wendy Burgess has worked in the golf course industry, specializing in environmental policy and operations. As Director of Corporate Environmental Policy and Operations for ClubLink Corporation, Ms. Burgess has overseen approvals for water taking, sewage and water treatment systems, and works directly with the Corporation's management teams on issues related to environmental policy, regulations and best management practices. She has been directly involved in capital upgrades and new construction of sewage and water facilities. Her role also includes managing the sewage and potable water operations at ClubLink's 43 properties comprised of golf courses, resorts and residential developments. ClubLink owns and operates numerous golf courses across the CTC Region.

Ms. Burgess has sat on various committees including the IPM Council of Canada, Rouge Watershed Task Force, York Region Low Water Response Team, and the Ontario Allied Golf Association's environmental team.

Prior to working at ClubLink Corporation, Ms. Burgess worked as a policy research assistant for the Urban Development Institute, participating in various committees established by the Institute, including the Planning and Environment Committee. She also held the position of watershed plan coordinator for the Nottawasaga Valley Conservation Authority and assisted with developing the Nottawasaga Valley Watershed Plan; one of seven pilot projects funded by the Provincial Government in the early 1990s.
