She is an avid participant in local tree plantings, invasive species pulls, and watershed tours. As a community volunteer she has developed knowledge and appreciation of the expertise, continuous improvement, and progress being made to keep our watersheds and communities healthy.

Rosemary is Chairperson of the local chapter of Sierra Club of Canada - Peel Group. She and Sierra Peel colleagues have attended CVC and TRCA Board meetings to observe the proceedings, to bring delegations on local concerns, and to learn up to date information from staff presentations. She leads Sierra Peel volunteers in facilitating outreach on environmental issues at community events in Brampton and Mississauga, bringing the message that natural heritage protection benefits us all, and our river systems and watersheds are resources to be valued and protected for the long term.
